Mr Clarke was 76 years of age and had lived in Gaywood all his life on leaving school went to work at Ladymans and Savages, before gaining an apprenticeship as a carpenter joiner with Medwells Builders. On completion of this he worked for them at Pauls Mill. Then came the depression and he went to work on King's Lynn docks, and was in the ARP from 1938 to 1940. He joined the RAFVR as a carpenter/boat builder with Air Sea Rescue Service and saw service in Scotland, Shetland Isles, Ireland and Far East. Promoted to Sergeant boatbuilder (South East Asia Command) he was in Bombay, Calcutta, and Rangoon in Bur-

After the war he came back to Lynn docks, as carpenter and general foreman for 42 years until his retirement. Among his hobbies was gardening, painting, writing poems and his diary.

His main interest had been music and singing, he sang his first solo in Gaywood church at age of eighteen, and was a choir member of St Faith's, St Margaret's, Lynn Music Society, Wisbech Male Voice Choir and Shirley Singers. A powerful bass baritone singer he sang at many events in West Norfolk area. During the war he was a member of RAF Concert Party on board a transport going to India and at numerous RAF stations.
